Built in the UK, this latest DAF municipal range shows DAF's relentless pursuit of perfection and an ability to always make sure the needs of the operator come first.

Manoeuvrable, spacious and practical with outstanding fuel economy, combined with low emission design requiring minimum maintenance, gives the municipal range full marks all-round. Maximum uptime is of

paramount importance in any market sector and that's why DAF are focused on meeting the stringent operating requirements of local authorities and contractors. Making the vehicles ideal for sweeping, refuse and waste management applications.

There are three dedicated sweeper chassis available in the municipal range. The LF45 comes at either 7.5 or 12 tonnes, with a wheelbase of 3.15m and a choice of 160 hp and 180 hp engines respectively. The LF55 runs at 15 tonnes with a wheelbase of 3.24m and 160,180 or 220 hp engine. All of the sweepers come with left-hand drive as standard and are available at either Euro 4 or advanced Euro 5 emission levels depending on the choice of engine.

In addition to the sweepers, the range also includes the new DAF LF45 tipper. With its dedicated gearbox ratios, raised air intake and larger wheels and tyres for greater ground clearance, it's well equipped for the most demanding of environments. There's a choice of four wheelbases from 3.0 to 3.9m, engine powers of 140,160, 180 or 220 hp and a payload potential of up to 4.3 tonnes. Also available at 18 tonne the LF55 has a choice of 220, 250 or 290 hp making it the ideal choice for skip and tipper applications.

A greener choice

All PACCAR engines used throughout the DAF municipal range feature Selective Catalytic Reduction (SCR) technology to meet either Euro 4 or Euro 5 emission standards. SCR technology is simple, reliable and efficient – the clean route to a bright future.

SCR is the most popular choice because of its lower operating costs, its improved fuel efficiency, and the fact that it's simple and virtually maintenance free. Optimised combustion gives both class leading fuel efficiency, lower CO₂ emissions, strong performance and high levels of durability and reliability, leading to lower costs of operation.

SCR is tried and tested technology – and DAF has made the best use of it, combining it with additional engine improvements such that the Euro 5 160 hp derivative even meets Enhanced Environmentally friendly Vehicle (EEV) exhaust emission levels originally only achievable with gas powered vehicles.

DAF SCR provides an improved engine performance, delivering up to 290 hp from its fuel efficient 4.5 and 6.7 litre engines in the LF45 and LF55. The CF75 and CF85 series range is available at up to 510 hp again at either Euro 4 or Euro 5 emission levels.
